CPD Programme 2017/18

Below is the model of CPD for all staff for the year ahead. There will be 8 CPD sessions on a Wednesday and 2 hours to be used for TeachMeet Lite.

Main scale teachers' CPD will be selected during the final appraisal review meeting. The choice will be based upon areas of need for development from the lesson observations and from the appraisals process itself. This choice is made for the year as a whole.

All Staff

- Either: Programme of workshops (4 compulsary sessions and one session from the remaining 4 CPD weeks).
- Or: Action Research
- External CPD linked to Appraisal targets.
- Induction programme
- Open Classroom Weeks/Spotlighting Competitions

Middle Leaders

- Joint observation.
- Audit/inspection experience.
- Programme of middle leader workshops.
- Internship programmes (internal and external)

SLT

- Job shadowing/skills exchange
- Training sessions on strategic issues, leadership skills etc.
- Internship programmes (internal and external)

Middle and senior leaders will access the same programme as main scale teachers but will have the additional training as outlined above. Middle leaders will be supported with lesson observations by carrying them out with their peers or their line manager. They will also be encouraged to take part in audits at other Ormiston schools.

Senior leaders also need to be receiving regular professional development, which is specific to their remit and which helps them to develop further. To support this, a programme of skills exchanging will take place, where SLT will identify skills gaps and work with each other to develop them. There will also be several SLT specific workshops focusing on leadership and strategic issues. SLT CPD sessions will take place during SLT meetings.

External CPD will be closely linked to Appraisal targets and department development plans to ensure that departments access the training they need and that the impact of the T&L budget can be clearly tracked.

Workshops:

The workshops programme consists of the 4 compulsory sessions and a free choice of 4 additional workshops on the remaining CPD weeks.

Lesson Studies:

Action Research is a year-long programme involving the exploration of and reflection upon teaching. The programme involves working on a topic of interest individually or as a group. The final result of the study is likely to be a research poster or written report. There are strong links with the UEA, which has led to such articles being published in educational journals.

Open Classroom Weeks:

Open classroom weeks are a great way to get out and see what teaching is happening across the academy. There will be two of these throughout the year and a timetable of available lessons for observation will be shared in advance.
