Definition of epic (*adjective*) in English

1. Noting or pertaining to a long poem, usually centered upon a hero, in which a series of great achievements or events is narrated in elevated style: Homer's Iliad is an epic poem.
2. Resembling or suggesting such poetry: an epic novel on the founding of the country.
3. Heroic; majestic; impressively great.
4. Of unusually great size or extent.
