**Re: Academy Behaviour Policy**

As an academy, we expect and promote the highest standards within our classrooms to ensure every child has maximum opportunity for success. Your children deserve to learn in a calm and productive environment. With this in mind, we have made the following changes to our behaviour policies to bring further rigour to our sanctions.

- Staff will continue to use a range of positive behaviour strategies to support students to remain on task including praise, verbal warnings and the academy visual warning system.
- If your child is removed from a lesson due to disruptive behaviour they will receive 30 minute, after-school detention on the same day. You will receive a text to inform you of this consequence to enable you to amend your arrangements as necessary. If your child is unable to attend the detention, please contact the academy as soon as possible to discuss.
- If your child is removed from more than one lesson in a day or involved in a more serious incident, they will receive a day of isolation in the Inclusion Room. During this day they will be set work from their normal lessons which they will complete independently and in silence. They will also have time to reflect on their actions and will be supported with any restorative work that may be required. Students will have their break and lunch at a different time to the rest of the school, to reinforce this sanction.
- If your child is going to be in Inclusion for the day, you will be informed by the academy. Your child should not go to form, but register in the Year Team Office by 8.40am at the latest.
- From this September the Inclusion day will be extended to 3.45pm. However, students who meet all expectations of their day in Inclusion will be released at 3.15pm.
