Year 11	Topics covered: Promotion, Finance, People in business. This external component builds on knowledge, understanding and skills acquired and developed in Components 1 and 2 and includes synoptic assessment. Learners will be provided with a case study of a small to medium enterprise (SME), and a series of activities to complete. This component is assessed by a written assessment set and marked by Pearson. The external assessment will be 2 hours in length. The number of marks for the assessment is 60. Component 2: Learners will individually select an idea for a micro-enterprise activity to plan and pitch. They will individually pitch their business plan for their idea to an audience and then use the feedback to review their plan and pitch. Skills: Analytical ability, communication and presentation skills, goal setting, leadership skills, numeracy, problem solving, team work, time management.
